Comprehensive Plan Update: Staff provided update on changes to the new comprehensive plan that was approved a couple of years ago. The intent was to increase citizen involvement, but feedback was not positive. Most of us felt that the process was to eliminate the residents from the process. The old process was time consuming with reviews by the land use committee of all nominations for changes to the plan. They now have neighborhood planning studies, an activity center for future plans. Energy Savings on Steroids

May 9th Speaker on Geothermal **Energy in BBHCA**

We all know that the local cost of living continues to rise in the DC area, while salaries remain flat at best, putting the squeeze on everyone who isn't not have the necessary number of a lobbyist or stadium owner. Thus, BBHCA has a tradition of occasionally inviting speakers to our meetings to tell us about ways we can save on home energy costs. This May 9th we have a presentation you will not want to miss because the EPA estimates that geothermal savings on home heating and cooling typically range from 45-75%. We have obtained Richard Lay as our May 9th speaker, a member of the International Ground Source Heat Pump Association and one of the principles of North American Geothermal. Mr. Lay will fill us in on geothermal energy systems—how they work, the facts and figures behind their rapidly expanding use in Virginia and nationally, and how they save money spent on energy, maintenance, and replacement. A BBHCA member with a geothermal system will also be on hand to answer questions about their experiences. This is a unique opportunity to get first-hand information from an expert on a system that is being installed all over the world in every type of climate, but is fairly new to most of us. BBHCA has been getting some exceptional speakers in the last few years please join us at our May 9th BBHCA meeting, 7:30 pm at Bush Hill Elementary School, to hear one of these for yourself.



Rose Hill Drive to be Paved this Fall

Street Repaving continues in the Franconia area this fall. Although Virginia DOT rated pavement in Brookland-Bush Hill as "very poor" in 2016, the target this fall is Rose Hill Drive. It will be repaved from Franconia Road to Telegraph Road. In addition, two important commuter routes to North Kings Highway are being repaved: Dorset Drive between Telegraph Road and The Parkway and The Parkway itself between Telegraph Road and North Kings Highway.

We don't know yet if Rose Hill Drive will be painted with bicycle lanes. The road connects our neighborhood with the Library and with the Park entrance so it makes sense to me. The Public Facilities Manual is a tough master and bike lanes may not be allowed by it. I'll report on the final design for Rose Hill Drive in the next issue of Brookland-Bush Hill News.

Spring Plant Sale

Our last land use meeting was in March 2017. Below is an update on the two applications from that meeting.

Greenspring Village Cell Tower: Recommended for Approval (15-0-0). A process was approved to deal with requests from applicants to re-hear applications that were not approved (11-0-3).

Embark – Richmond Highway: County Staff presented a brief overview of plans for expanding public transportation in the Route 1 corridor. This would require Comprehensive Plan Amendment. Under consideration are BRT (bus rapid transit) like No. Arlington, south of
